Day 1

A.S. College of Education Khanna, organised “Seven Days Faculty Development Programme” in association with Panjab University, sponsored by Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (Hydrabad), Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India from 18 Nov. to 24 Nov. 2018.

Prof. Nandita Singh (Co-coordinator interdisciplinary Center for Swami Vivekananda Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh and the University Coordinator of this programme) was the Chief Guest and Sh. Tarsem Bahia. (Former Principal, A.S.College of Khanna) was Guest of Honour of this programme. Sh. Priyavart Sharma & Priyank Goswami (Faculty Members and Programme Co-ordinators from MGNCRE, Hydrabad), Sh. Madan Lal Sharma (Secretary A.S. College of Education), Sh. Sudershan Verma (Secretary A.S College, Khanna), Dr. Vijay Laxmi (Principal, D.D Jain College of Education, Ludhiana) and faculty members of various educational institutions graced the function with their presence.

The Program started with Jyoti Prajwalan ceremony followed by the Panjab University Anthem.



Dr. Shilpy Arora gave a brief introduction Faculty Development Programme- Nai Talim, Work Education, Experiential learning and Community Engagement. She said This programme is focus to promote Gandhiji,s ideas to give education to human for productive work and permote dignity of labour.

Then Dr. Shilpy Arora gave a brief introduction about Guest of Honour Sh. Tarsem Bahia sir and requested him to share his views. She explained the meaning of Nai Talim and Experiential learning and also elaborate that how can a teacher educator can apply it in everyday teaching by giving latest examples and information in the field of education.



Then Dr. Shilpy Arora gave a brief introduction about Chief Guest Prof. Nandita Singh and requested her to share her views. He relate and compare the Nai Talim with the old education system by giving examples of personal experiences. He said today is the need to bring the old education system where education was based on the wok and crafts with changes suitable to present scenario.



Then Dr. Shilpy Arora gave a brief introduction about Sh. Priyavart Sharma (Faculty Member and Programme Co-ordinator from MGNCRE, Hydrabad) and requested him to share his views. He elaborate about the Faculty Development Programme and the objectives which have to achieved during the programme.



After that Management Members and Off. Principal gave award of honour to Chief Guest and Guest of Honour. Then Dr. Shilpy Arora requested Mrs. Vimal Vidushy, (Off. Principal of College) to gave a vote of thanks. She thanked the Chief Guest, Guest of Houour, Management Members, Programme Co-ordinators and all the participants from various colleges of Punjab.



After lunch break, In the first session i.e. “Nai Talim for School Curricular Areas” of the Programme, All participants were divided into groups and told them to give a innovative name. Groups had given the names like Arybhatta, Einstein, Mahatma Gandhi, Arya Samaj etc. Then the groups were instructed to frame the activities and also given a format to fill according to the activity framed on the different topics from class VIth to Xth curriculum as given in the book “Nai Talim”. Then each group presented that activity. The session was concluded with suggestions regarding reforms in curriculum as according to objectives of Mahatma Gandhi.



After tea break in the last session- ‘Nai Talim and NCF 2005, NCFTE 2010 and RTE 2009’, all participants listen the audio of National Curriculum Framework (NCF-2005), NCFTE 2010 and RTE 2009. Then all participants discuss the obstacles occurring in implication and execution of NCF, NCFTE and RTE in our present system.

Day-2

Second day started with the discussion on NCF 2005, NCFTE 2010 and RTE 2009 to recap the key learning points. To find the real implication of Nai Talim, in session- 'Nai Talim Film (Case Method for Work Education)', a documentary video of Anand Niketan School was shown to the participants of FDP. In that school the curriculum is based on learning by doing and skill oriented activities like doing work in fields to get knowledge about agriculture, packaging, household activities, economic activities etc.



The second video of Baba Aya Singh School, Riarki Gurdaspur, was shown to participants. In that school students are very much self reliant. Whole administration of school is under the control of students themselves like teaching, examination, cleanliness etc. In that school there is no teacher, senior students teach the juniors. In that school environment is totally different from the environment of present general schools.

After tea break, there was a discussion on videos by the participants and all express their views and try to find out the loops and holes in our present education system.



In next session- 'Education relating to life-Work Education and its implications', all the participants were divided into groups and told them to give a innovative name. Groups had given the names like Leader group, Galaxy etc. Then the groups were instructed to frame the activities and also given a format to fill according to the activity framed on the different topics from the assigned typology of class Ist to Vth curriculum as given in the book "Nai Talim". All participants prepared creative lesson plan based on particular format covering the domains: Head (Cognitive)-knowledge, Heart (Affective)-Attitude, Psychomotor (Hand)-Skill and then presented by each group and handover the document of format to MGNCRE coordinator.



After lunch break, in the next session-‘Work Education’ a workshop on craft was organized. All participants made caps from newspapers and eye masks from paper. All enjoyed and learn a lot in that skill oriented session and how to apply in classroom.



Day- 3

Third day started with Meditation. For the session-‘Analysis of B.Ed Curriculum and preparing Work Education activities’, the participants were divided into groups to an experiential learning activities with steps, precautions, tools, checklists and evaluation from B.Ed Curriculum on the objective of Nai Talim and presented by the group members.



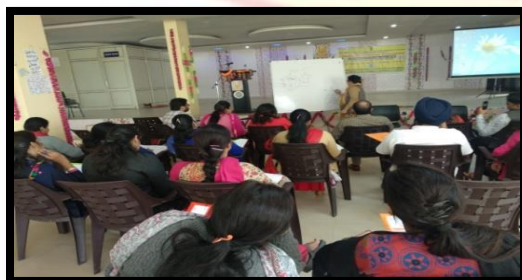


After tea break, in next session-‘Work Education’, Candle making workshop was organized. Mrs. Karmandeep Kaur taught different designs of candles from different types of wax and all participants made candles with great zeal and enthusiasm. All enjoyed a lot by learning skill oriented -work.

Two children from Khanna demonstrate the Dhol (Musical Instrument) made by themselves with waste material. They also learn how to play dhol from You-tube. It is not only the big achievement of them but also for a society for having human resources like them.



After lunch break, in the next session- an activity was organized in which a massage was given to transfer one to another to enhance the listening skill.



In the next session Prof. Latika Sharma (Chairperson, Department of Education, P.U. Chandigarh) share her views on the topic “How to develop Social Commitment among students” through different activities and model presentation. She organized many activities based on the objectives of Nai Talim.

After tea break there was clay modeling session in which different teams made different things from clay. All participants actively participated as all got an opportunity to show their creativity through clay modeling.



In the last session, off. Principal Mrs. Vimal Vidushy discuss about PRA and PLA based on next day field visit. She discussed about what things have to keep in mind like resources, areas to be covered, problems to be discussed with villagers, material required to execute the activities etc. during field visits.



Day -4

On the fourth day of FDP all participants visited Govt. Sen. Sec. School Lalheri, where all participants executed the activities framed on first and second day. All the teams actively performed the activities with school children like different shapes of geometry, adjectives, perimeter of the different shapes, conductor and insulator etc. and evaluate the learning. Students of the school participated enthusiastically



After school visit there was tea break and then all the FDP participants move to village Rahoun to communicate the people of village. Each team given different areas to cover different issues like issues related to youth, women, old persons, farmers and health issues etc. All teams survey the community and closely interact with villagers accordingly and find many problems like lack of awareness, sanitation, water problems etc.. Participants come to know about their skills, living style, simplicity, heritage, goodness, cooperation, belongingness and other values which are decreasing day by day from our India. It was a great opportunity for all the participants to visit real world of work where people do hand work like dari, diya and tokri making etc.



After lunch all teams draw social mapping with the help of collected data in which they have shown the various resources of the village.

Day 5

On the fifth day all participants went to Doraha College of Education, Doraha, where all participants in groups executed the activities framed on third day of programme, like kitchen gardening, communication, farming etc. All groups facilitate the B.Ed students with experiential manner. Asst. Prof. Hari Krishan from A.S.College of Education taught the students with meditation activity with which they can increase their concentration power in studies as well as in their life.



After tea break our Programme Co-ordinator Sh. Priyavert thanked the Principal of Doraha College of Education. Then Mr. Sandeep Sawhney (Principal, Doraha College of Education) thanked to participants of FDP to taught and to executed activity based on Nai Talim and Experiential Learning and also to encourage their students.

After that all participants visit 'Mughal Sarai' in Doraha and appreciated the skill work done at the time of Mughals



After the lunch break in the next session all share views regarding the visit in Govt. Sen. Sec. School, Ialheri, village Rahoun and Doraha College of Education, Doraha. At last Mr. Priyank Goswami (Programme Co-ordinator) sum up the session.

Day-6

All groups exchanged their views about the school and community visit where they discuss about the problems faced by schools like lack of infrastructure, lack awareness among parents etc. They also discuss about the problems faced by the villagers like lack of facilities, lack of awareness, problems concerning sanitation and water etc.



After tea break a workshop on 'Work Education' was organized in which Dr. Sushma Singla (Asso. Prof. A.S. College for Women, Khanna) taught how to make Rangoli colours with wood powder and marble. She also taught Tie and Dye of cloths. All participants actively participated and made tie and die clothes. She also discussed how these activities will help in making students self reliant.



After Lunch break a Book 'Naya Janoon' was given to each group. Different chapters to read were distributed among different groups and were instructed to read. Each person analysed the chapter after reading.

After Tea break all groups were instructed to write report on all the days of workshop.

Day 7

Seventh Day started with discussion about college visit. All discussed about the activities performed during college visit. Dr. Ajay shared the activity of vermicomposting, which is an organic fertilizer prepared with the help of earthworms. Mrs. Sangeeta shared the activity of kitchen gardening by the use of waste cardboard and plastic papers. Dr. Gurwinder shared the views concerning awareness about employment through media. Mrs. Kavita taught meditation to all the participants of FDP which was executed by Mr. Harikishan in Doraha College of Education. All felt very relaxed after doing meditation.

After tea break, all groups had given presentation about whole six days activities; school and community visit and exchange their views.

After Lunch break, Valedictory function was held.
